Freed From Within is a not-for-profit Christian After-Jail Mentoring Program serving Christ in Floyd and Harrison Counties in Indiana. Persons released from jail can successfully return to the community and their families, and begin productive lives as Christians freed from within. We will be collecting money for this mission throughout the conference so be sure to bring some extra money to help out our cause.

Beyond that, we are asking youth groups and individuals to help us out by gathering the materials for "health kits" for this ministry. A "health kit" should include a towel, washcloth, toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, soap, deodorant, nail clippers, comb, three safety razors, six band aids, a roll of toilet paper. Rules of Conduct

We expect each student to conform to these rules of conduct.

- 1. Students will RESPECT self, others and all property using GOOD BEHAVIOR.**
- Poor behavior that is dangerous, disrespectful, disobedient, rude or any other behavior that is disruptive will not be tolerated.
- 2. Students will SPEAK words of purity and edification** (speech used to build someone up). - Foul language is NOT permitted. This includes degrading speech, sexual innuendoes, course jokes, crass descriptions; swear words and any other words that are impure. We are here to build people up not tear them down.
- 3. Possession of any weapons, tobacco, drugs or alcohol is not permitted.**
- 4. Attendees will LOVE each other, their leaders and other volunteers.**
(Absolutely NO fighting or instigating)
- 5. Students will wear appropriate and modest attire.** - No revealing tops or midriffs. Underwear is not to be seen. No short shorts. Students wearing inappropriate attire will be asked to change.
- 6. Students may perform appropriate friendly hugs.** - Absolutely no public displays of affection except for appropriate and encouraging hugs.
- 7. Students must be willing to follow directions and be submissive to authority figures and comply with everything above or face consequences.** (Consequences may include being sent home.)
